Beyond these days, any further days off will be unpaid unless they are due to illness. Again, I appreciate that reliable daycare is a necessity for many families, and will do my very best to limit time off and give advance notice as much ahead of time as possible. Please have backup childcare options available. However, if this presents a hardship to your family in your particular situation, I recommend that you consider placing your child in a daycare facility.
